DRONE TRAINING FOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS



Cloud County Community College Renewable Energy Technology will be providing comprehensive training this summer for those High School Teachers tasked with introducing drones into their curriculum.

PHASE 1

Online Ground School

(24 clock hours)

Must be completed before Phase 2

DATES:

The online portion must be completed before attending the second phase of the training

PHASE 2

On-Campus Flight School Workshop

(2 days)

DATES:

May 30 & 31 or
August 5 & 6

COST:

Early Bird:

\$700 per participant
(deadline: May 10)

After May 10: \$750

Upon successful completion of both phases, you will receive:

- Unmanned Safety Institute Ground School Certificate
- Cloud County Community College Flight School Certificate
- 36 points for Professional Development

This training will help you introduce drones to your high school students and prepare you to take the Part 107 Remote Pilot Exam

Training will be provided by CCC's Certified Unmanned Safety Institute Instructors, both with Part 107 Remote Pilot Licenses, Monte Poersch and Stacey Baker.
